Cottingley Surgery

The group were informed that as from July 2017 Windsor House Group Practice had taken on an additional practice at Cottingley until 31-03-2018. The CCG had approached WHGP to support the patients of Cottingley whilst there was a full patient consultation process carried out to identify further needs for the area. It was unclear at the moment if the contract would be extended after end of March. The PPG would be informed of any changes going forward.

Call Centre Implementation / Impact - Monthly Statistics

SH updated the group around call centre team method of answering patient calls. The team have been up and running since the beginning of January 2017. The telephone monitoring system was now in place and as such the following data was fed back to the group:

Week Commencing 10th July 2017 the practice received 531 calls (17 were unanswered) and the average call waiting time was 1 min 21 seconds.

Week Commencing 17th July 2017 the practice received 498 calls (21 were unanswered) and the average call waiting time was 1 min 14 seconds.

The initial feedback from the data seems that calls are being answered more quickly and a reduction in calls unanswered. The practice will continuously monitor the situation and will feedback to the next PPG meeting where we will have had a couple of months data to report back on.

Practice Data

The group were provided with a draft document highlighting certain types of data that the practice found useful when making key decisions – examples of these were:
